STAGING INSTRUCTIONS

Stage setup amongst the wind and brass players is quite flexible. One suggested configuration is to seat, from left to right, the two flutes, the first clarinet, the first bassoon, and the two oboes (six players) in a horseshoe at the front of the stage. The percussion, two horns, bass clarinet, contrabassoon, trombone, bass trombone, harp, and double bass (nine players) would then set up, from left to right, in a second horseshoe behind the first.

The percussion should be set up in three primary stations with a fourth, more flexible station. These are: Station I - Marimba and Crotales; Station 2 - Vibraphone and Gong; Station 3 - Tubular Bells and Suspended Cymbal; Station 4 - Bass Drum and Tam Tam. The only additional requirement is that the gong be quite be near the suspended cymbal. In all likelihood, it will be easiest to arrange Station 2 between Station I and Station 3. Station 4 can be placed quite freely, since the bass drum and tam-tam do not enter until quite late in the work.


























































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
